D'Addario Phosphor Bronze strings are precision wound with corrosion resistant phosphor bronze onto a carefully drawn, hexagonally shaped, high carbon steel core. The result is long lasting, bright sounding tone with excellent intonation. D'Addario J76's are designed and gauged for the mandola, tuned in fifths to the same pitches as a viola, C to A.
