This feature makes the harmonica very service-friendly and is resistant against moisture as well as gliding easily on the lips. Chrometta 8 design includes an enclosed mouthpiece and slide mechanism which allows you to blow straight at the reed plates, creating a tone that is clear and consistent with strong projection. The enclosed cover design insures a rich, full resonance.
